**Tuesdays - Hedgehogs PE and Y1 PE**

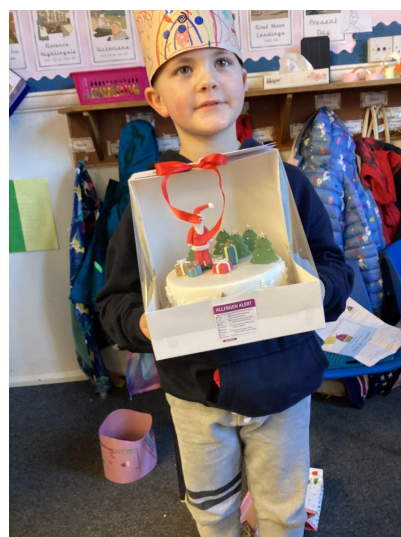
