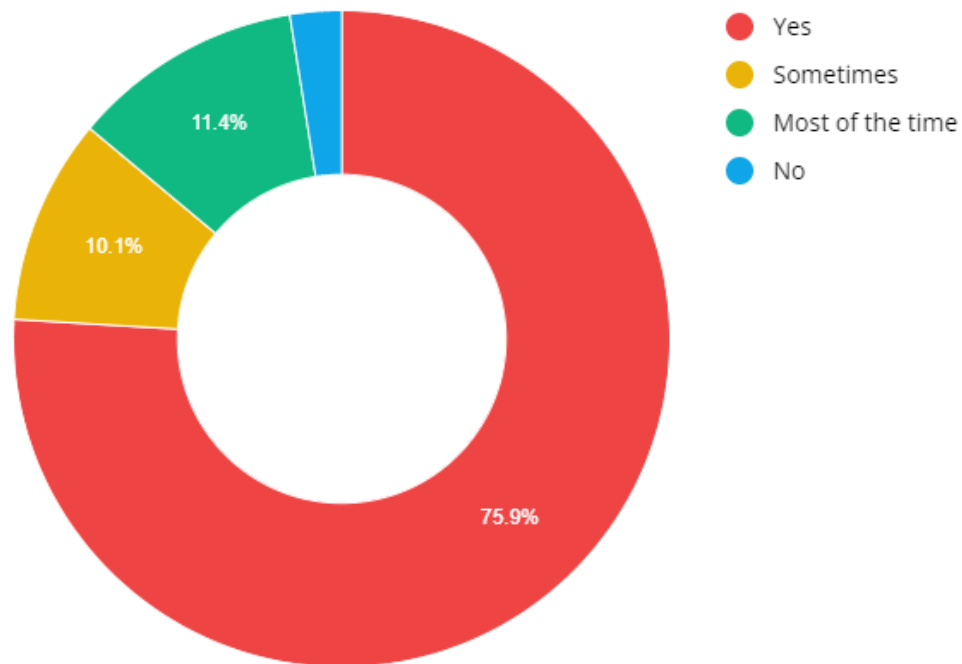

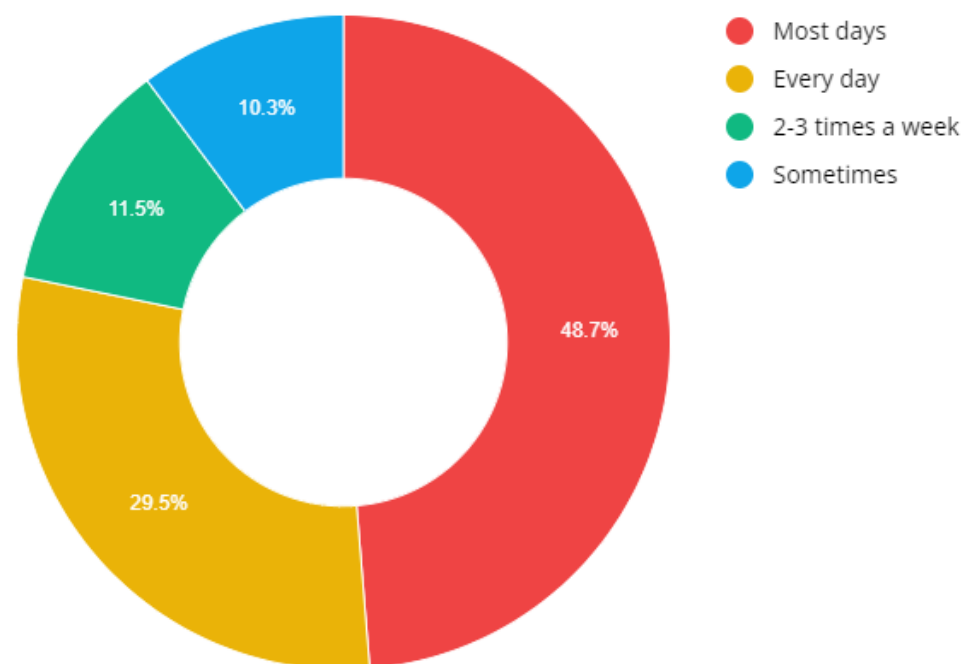

My teachers help me to improve my work

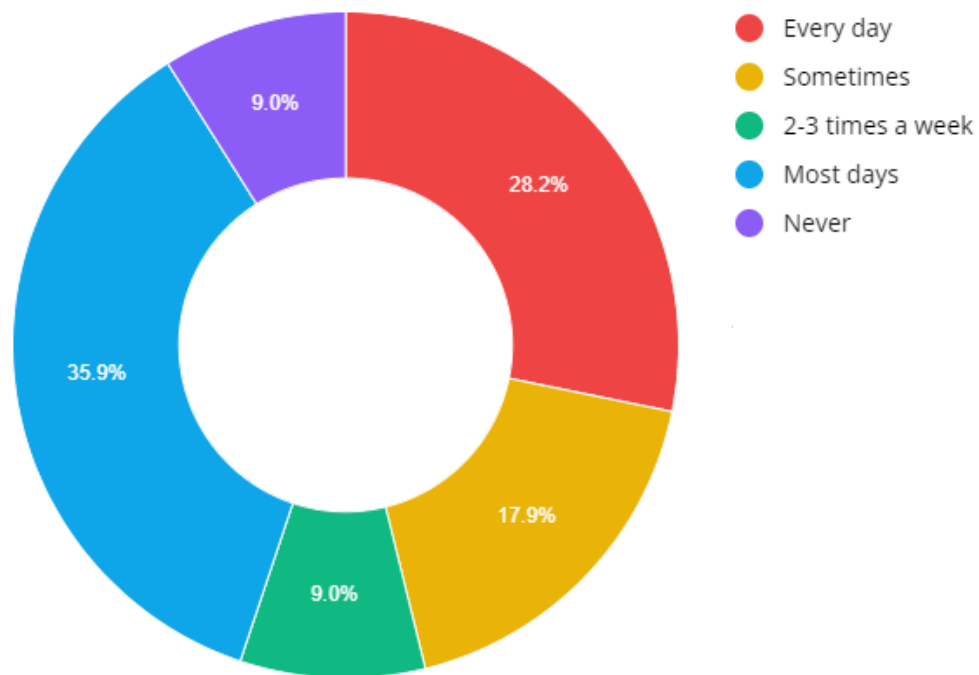


I read my reading book at home

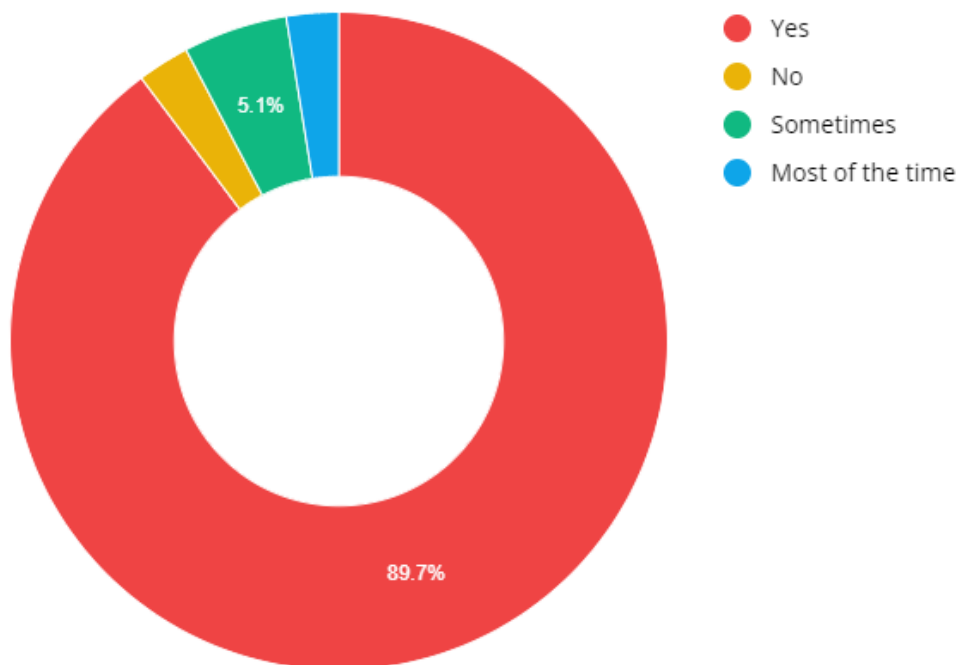

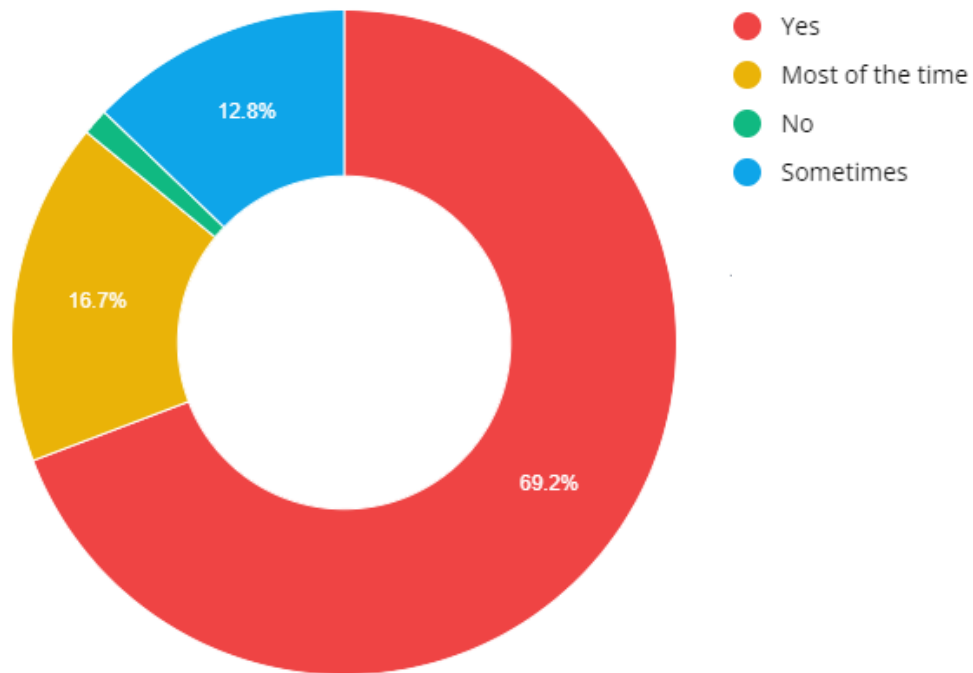

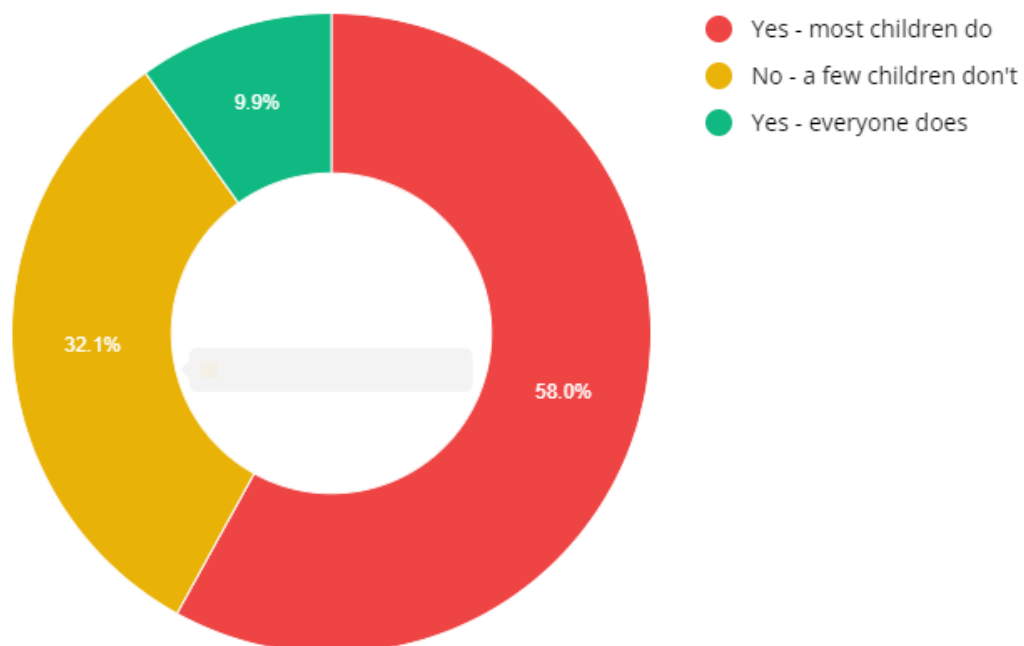

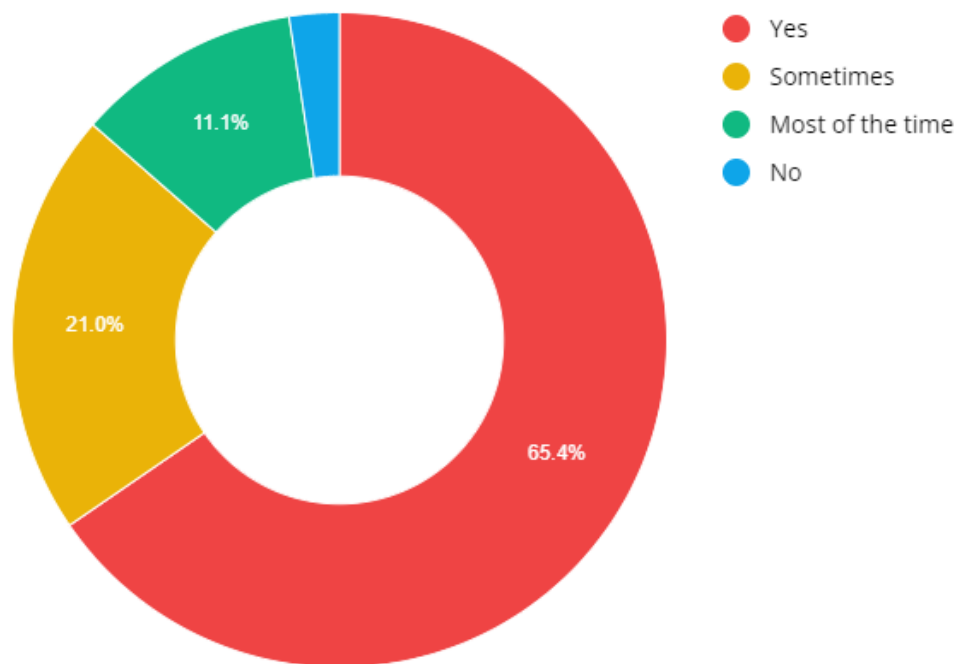


Children in my class behave well
